Day 11 – Jan 23 | Embracing Spirit Empowered Prayer

1. Lord, thank you for the privileged access to your throne of grace in prayer, and the assurance that you hear us and will grant our request for the manifestation of your greater glory in and through us (Matthew 7:7-11, Hebrews 4:16, 1 John 5:14-15, Psalm 34:17, Jeremiah 33:3)
2. Lord, we embrace the leadership and enabling power of the Holy Spirit for prayer that builds up God's greater glory in and through us, overcoming every form of weakness in the flesh (Matthew 26:41, Romans 8:26, Jude 1:20)
3. Lord, release upon every member of the Hilltop an extraordinary measure of the spirit of prayer with power to produce great results for your greater glory. (Philippians 4:6, Hebrews 5:7, Mark 1:35, Luke 6:12, James 5:16b)
4. Lord, may every member of the Hilltop grow more intimate with you in prayer and worship - abiding in you and you in us, for exponential increase in faith that opens doors for answered prayers (John 9:31, John 15:7, 1 John 3:22, Romans 10:17, Mark 11:24)
5. Lord, we receive the grace to be always alert, praying without ceasing in every season for the manifestation of the will of God here on earth as it is in heaven (1 Thessalonians 5:17, Ephesians 6:18, Psalm 55:17, Colossians 4:2)
6. Lord, destroy everything in us that hinder prayers including pride, unconfessed sin, anger, quarreling, grudges, wrong motives, doubt/unbelief (2 Chronicles 7:14, Isaiah 59:2, 1 Timothy 2:8, James 4:3, 1:6-7)
7. Lord, make everyone at the Hilltop a watchman (skillful prayer warriors and strategic / tactical intercessors) devoted to praying together and specifically for the lost and laborers for the coming harvest at the Hilltop (Ezekiel 3:16-17, Matthew 21:12-13, 18:19-20, Acts 1:14, 2:42-47, Matthew 9:35-38)
8. Lord, your peace will guard our hearts, and our joy will be full as we ask for and receive the manifestation of your greater glory in and through us (Philippians 4:7, John 16:23-24)
9. Lord, make us disciplined prayer warriors that will never give up in prayer until our Jerusalem becomes a praise (Isaiah 62:7)
