Day 12 – Jan 24 | Yes Always to the Holy Spirit

1. Father, we bury the old do-it-yourself life and follow your voice, yielding ourselves to the Holy Spirit for things to do and places to go for the manifestation of your greater glory (Romans 8:12-14, John 10:25-30)
2. Father, every heart at the Hilltop will hear your every call to fellowship with the Holy Spirit and always respond “I am coming” (Psalm 27:8, Revelation 22:17, Joshua 24:14-15)
3. Father, we are instructed by the Holy Spirit in wisdom, understanding and knowledge for divine direction and accomplishments in our lives and ministry (John 14:26, Acts 13:1-2, Proverbs 24:3-4)
4. Father, we receive clear directions to Wisdom Way and Righteous Road. Open our ears and impress us with your counsel so that we do not end up in blind alleys or waste time making wrong turns. (Proverbs 4:10-15, Job 33:15-18)
5. Father, we receive intelligence, discernment, clear and focused eyes to see exactly what you are calling us to do and to grasp the immensity and utter extravagance of your greater glory work in and through us (Ephesians 1:15-19)
6. Father, we give room for our assigned angels who are quick to hear and do what God says, to lead us in the right direction (Hebrews 1:14, Psalm 103:20-22)
7. Father, we humble ourselves before you Lord and trust you to get us up and going on our feet filled with your wisdom. We yell a loud No to the devil and his counsel becomes scarce in our midst (James 4:7-10, 1:5-8)
8. Father, we receive the courage and boldness to speak and act on your divine counsel for divine intervention in our lives and ministry (Exodus 14:15-16)
9. Father, every stronghold that stands in the way of our divine revelation for your greater glory assignment is rooted out and destroyed (Isaiah 6:1-8)
10. Father, let everyone be at peace with the counsel of God for the Hilltop USA ministry, keeping us in step with each other and none going off and doing their own thing (Colossians 3:15-17)
11. Father, we enter a covenant to seek you with all our heart and soul. We shout out our oath of loyalty to the Lord with a loud voice, with shouting, with trumpets, and with cornets and look forward to rest on every side (2 Chronicles 15:12-15)
12. Father, may your counsel set us up on a solid rock and bring us to the place of total abandonment of ourselves to your Holy Spirit (Psalm 40:1-3, Zechariah 4:6, John 15:5)
